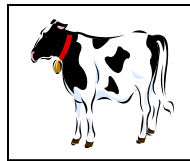

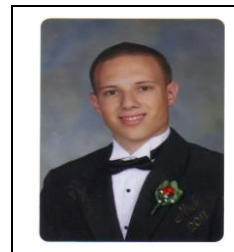

## Philmont April Training Hike

Meet at the church at 7:00 am on Saturday morning. Pack according to the attached list of things to bring to Philmont. We will be carrying full packs with all the gear taken to Philmont.

The only difference will be that we will carry one day of food instead of up to four days like at the ranch. Leave room in your pack to carry part of a tent, and other gear, in addition to your personal things and your share of the food. We will start on the Appalachian Trail at Port Clinton in the morning. Port Clinton is located on Route 61 a couple miles north of Cabelas. We will

hike roughly 9 miles on Saturday and another 6 miles on Sunday morning. We will be back at the church on Sunday afternoon between 2:00 and 3:00 pm. We will give parents an hour's warning when we will be back at the church. The cost of

this trip is \$12.00 a person. Please turn the money and permission slip in by Monday, April 11th. **Remember**, all Philmont participants are required to do three of the four hikes (October, 2010, March, April and June, 2011).
