## THE LAW OF THE TROOP

Beside the twelve points of the Boy Scout Law, members of Troop 20 are expected to conduct themselves in an orderly manner during **all** Troop meetings and functions. If a Scout's behavior is deemed unacceptable, certain disciplinary action will take place.

If the scout is: fighting, pushing, wrestling, any unnecessary roughness or destroying property, or engaging in any activity that is deemed unsafe, unhealthy or unlawful and not following the Scout Law:

1 <sup>st</sup> Offense	Sit out the rest of meeting. Discussion with Scout.
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense	Miss next meeting and there will be a discussion with parents and Scout.
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense	Meet with Troop Committee to discuss future with Troop 20 and Scouting. Communication with parents regarding problem and resolution.
If the scout is: lyin	g, cheating, stealing, willful destruction of other property:

1 <sup>st</sup> Offense	Sit out the rest of meeting; miss the next meeting and discussion with parents and Scout.
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense	Meet with Troop Committee to discuss future with Troop 20 and Scouting. Communication with parents regarding problem and resolution.

**Note:** Other disciplinary actions may be implemented depending on the misbehavior:

- 1. Writing a hundred word essay about the reason why they should follow rules.
- 2. Scout may not be able to participate in the next troop activity/trip.
- 3. The Troop Committee will determine if sufficient time has elapsed between incidents.

## **DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:**

It is the responsibility of any Scout to pay for property which was damaged or destroyed by that Scout. This will be our policy whether the damage was done accidentally or otherwise. This Scout will take part in no Troop activities until proper restitution is made.
